

CREATIVITY:

“Fear for the future” of Africa

Assignment: Choose from the following countries/people then create a finished product that will express to the class exactly what the theme “fearful for the future” means to your country.

1. You will create a piece of artwork that represents your country from Africa. It can be in any medium (for example: if your “conflict” theme is the rights of women in Africa and you choose to write a song, then sing it in class...That is excellent).
 - My wish is for you to be as creative as possible while thinking outside “the box” with this assignment, and still accomplishing the task of learning.
2. Write a two-page explanation about your country’s theme and exactly what you have created to represent it and why.
 - Include all of the research that you collect along the way, and create an **MLA formatted bibliography**. If you are unsure about how to create an MLA bibliography go to the front page of the Sehome web-site for a link. (your final product will not be accepted with out the bibliography)

Topics: I would like you to choose from the following list of countries [in random order] from Africa. If you would like to use a country that is not on this list, please be sure to clear it with your teacher first. It is perfectly acceptable for two people to have the same country, but not the same “theme” from that country.

Points:

- Your Representation of the country from Africa --
30 points
 - 10 points for creativity.
 - 10 points for effort.
 - 10 points for depicting the country and “theme” you have chosen.
- The written portion -- 20 points
- 5 points for the bibliography.
- 5 points for an explanation of what you have created.
- 5 points for spelling, grammar, and neatness (might want to type it out rather than writing out by hand last minute).
- 5 points for the historical explanation of “theme” and country.
